Most Sundays, the *Ordinary of the Mass* (Lord, have mercy, Gloria, Holy, holy & Lamb of God) are sung in Latin. These texts can be found in the hymn book (no. 633). You are warmly encouraged to join in as you learn the chants. The Our Father will be sung in Latin until we are familiar with it.

The words, for your convenience, are as follows:

<i>Et ne nos indúcas in tentatiónem. Sed libera nos a malo.</i>	<i>And lead us not into temptation. But deliver us from evil.</i>
