Due to GDPR, Baptismal Certificates provided for First Communions were destroyed. Please provide a new one for Confirmation.

## 11am Solemn Mass

Most Sundays, the *Ordinary of the Mass* (Lord, have mercy, Gloria, Holy, holy & Lamb of God) are sung in Latin. These texts can be found in the hymn book (no. 633). You are warmly encouraged to join in as you learn the chants. The Our Father will be sung in Latin until we are familiar with it.
