## Catholic Education Sunday

Today we give thanks to God for the teachers, past and present who have worked to form our children. We pray especially for the current staff in St Brigid's, and (in this month of November) we remember those who have died.

### 11am Solemn Mass

Most Sundays, the *Ordinary of the Mass* (Lord, have mercy, Gloria, Holy, holy & Lamb of God) are sung in Latin. These texts can be found in the hymn book (no. 633). The Our Father will be also be sung in Latin. The words, for you convenience, are as follows:

*Et ne nos indúcas in tentatiónem.*

*Sed libera nos a malo.*

*Our Father, who art in heaven:  
hallowed be thy name.*

*Thy kingdom come.*

*Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.*

*Give us this day our daily bread,*

*and forgive us our trespasses,*

*as we forgive those who trespass against us.*

*And lead us not into temptation.*

*But deliver us from evil.*
