40 Hours' Adoration

Our 40 Hours' Adoration will begin next week, **SUNDAY JANUARY 30th** until **TUESDAY FEBRUARY 1st (Feast of St Brigid)**. This year we are delighted to welcome Father Antonio Allegritti, a young Priest of the Diocese of Avezzano, near Rome, as our preacher for all three days of the 40 Hours'. Fr Allegritti is studying for a doctorate in Fundamental Theology at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, is head of Youth Pastoral for his Diocese, and is already much sought after as a preacher of retreats.

3-day Candles are now available to purchase in memory of a Loved One, for a person who is sick, or for a Special Intention. Candles cost £3 each, and are available at the back of the church, or from the sacristy. Write your intention(s) on a sticker, and attach it (them) to your candle.

A Watcher's List can be found on the table in the porch. Please consider giving 30 minutes of your time to pray to, and protect, Jesus present in the Blessed Sacrament.

You are warmly asked to make an extra special effort to attend the Holy Hours and other services this year and - of course! - the Mass of our patroness on Tuesday evening at 7pm. Even though you could go to another parish for morning Mass on that day, do remember that it will be **Tuesday of the 4th Week of the Year** and not St Brigid!
