

Sacraments for Children 2024

First Confession and First Communion are made by application to the parish. The following is necessary to make such an application:

 Your child has been baptised
You and your child have been attending Sunday Mass in St Brigid's for six months or more

applied to the parish 5. Your child has completed two "All Stars'" catechism club sessions in the parish

Remaining All Stars' dates for this year are as follows:

First Communion: 13th, 14th, 20th, 21st March First Communion: 24th, 25th April Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. This is binding upon all Catholics aged 14- 59 years old. This is one of the

'Precepts of the Church'. The others are:

- 1. Attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation
- 2. Confession of serious sin at least once a year
- Reception of Holy Communion at least once a year during the Easter season (ordinarily Easter Sunday through Pentecost Sunday)
- 4. Observance of the days of fast and abstinence
- 5. Providing for the needs of the Church

Failure to keep the Precepts of the Church requires reception of the Sacrament of Confession- without which you may not receive Holy Communion.
